

## **ATTENTION ALL MEMBERS**

As we are all aware, due to the Covid 19 pandemic, the New York State Women's 600 Bowling Club tournament scheduled for June 12, 13 and 14, 2020 has been rescheduled for June 11, 12 and 13, 2021 and still will be hosted by the Electric City 600 Club in Schenectady. The free entry certificates of the 2019 winners will be honored at the 2021 tournament.

This virus has also affected the Sunday morning Annual Meeting. The Board has, for the safety of our membership, agreed to postpone the meeting until 2021.

USBC has provided the following resolutions that can be followed by our Club to resolve this issue:

"USBC recommends following State and Local public health guidelines to determine if we can hold our meeting later. The current local/state Boards can vote, by majority, to postpone the 2020 Annual Meetings. If the meeting is postponed, the only provision allowed by the board is to appoint positions to alleviate unnecessary vacancies. All amendments from 2020 would move forward to 2021 Annual Meeting for delegate/member action.

If postponed, the following would be the procedures to have your Board continue operations:

- a. If the Board members do not have term limits, they would remain in their current position until an election is held
- b. If your bylaws have term limits for positions (which our bylaws do contain term limits) and they are reached, those vacancies would be appointed by the President with Board approval until our 2021 Annual Meeting.

When the 2021 Annual Meeting is conducted, the 2020 approvals would be the first place of business. The delegates/members would act to approve the actions taken by the Board. Then the traditional 2021 Annual Meeting business would take place."

The Hall of Fame induction will take place at the Annual Meeting in 2021.
